

PRAYER FOR WALKING IN LOVE

Key Scripture: *“Be ye therefore followers of God, as dear children; And walk in love, as Christ also hath loved us, and hath given Himself for us an offering and a sacrifice to God for a sweet smelling savour (Ephesians 5:1-2).*

Key Thought: Love never fails (*See 1 Corinthians 13:8*).
