I know You are aware of the troubles I face, ⁶ and because You are, I am able to come boldly before Your throne of grace, realizing that I will receive Your mercy and Your grace to help me in my time of need. ⁷

I cast all my cares upon You because I know You care for me. ⁸ I know that no weapon that is formed against me will prosper, for this is my heritage as Your servant, O Lord. ⁹ Thank You, Father.
